



## SGA Code of Conduct

The highest form of sportsmanship will be expected from every SGA member. Members are obligated to avoid acts, which are unsportsmanlike or detrimental to the game of golf or have an adverse reflection on the SGA.

1. Loud, abusive, or profane language, club throwing or hitting balls indiscriminately is prohibited.
2. The *SGA Rules of Golf* will govern all rulings on golf etiquette.
3. Intentional talking, waving of club or making distracting noises after a player has addressed the ball will be prohibited.
4. All local course ground rules will be observed.
5. All members (and guests) should present a neat appearance and abide by local dress regulations.
6. All members (and guests) will behave in a gentlemanly or lady like manner during any SGA activity.
7. Unsolicited golf advice or comments on the abilities of an individual during an SGA activity are prohibited.
8. Players should avoid causing damage to the course by removing divots when taking practice swings or by hitting the head of a club into the ground, whether in anger or for any other reason.
9. Socialize at the next tee box. Leave the green immediately after the last person has putted. Post your scores at the next tee.
10. Carry extra clubs when leaving your cart – just in case – good rule is to bring 3 clubs to your ball.
11. We also follow the Golf Etiquette in Section I, of the USGA Rules of Golf.
